- Two people are required for the assembly.

- **The sloped shelves must not be used with shelving over 99" in height or with mezzanines.**

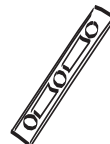

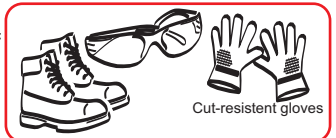

Set-up

- Check the leveling of the floor in order to determine the critical areas. Use floor anchor plates and shim plates to level the shelving units.
- Make sure that no obstacle nor electrical wiring comes in contact with the structure.

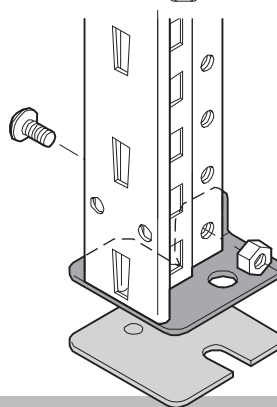

Recommendation:

Plumbness:

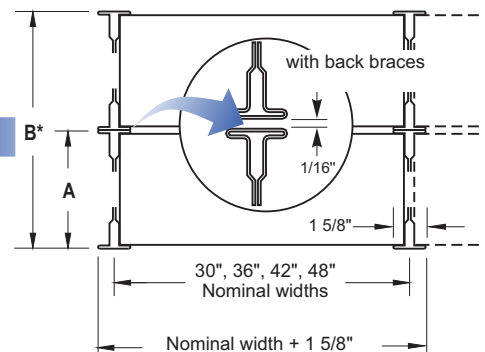
The shelving must be installed with a maximum tolerance from the vertical of 1/2" inch in 10 feet of height. Floor plates must be anchored if more than one shim is used.



Overall Dimensions

- It is recommended to lay out shelving positions on the floor with a chalkline before beginning the installation.

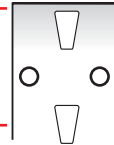
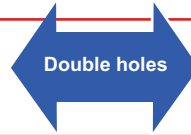
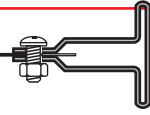




If using welded uprights, go directly to the next step.

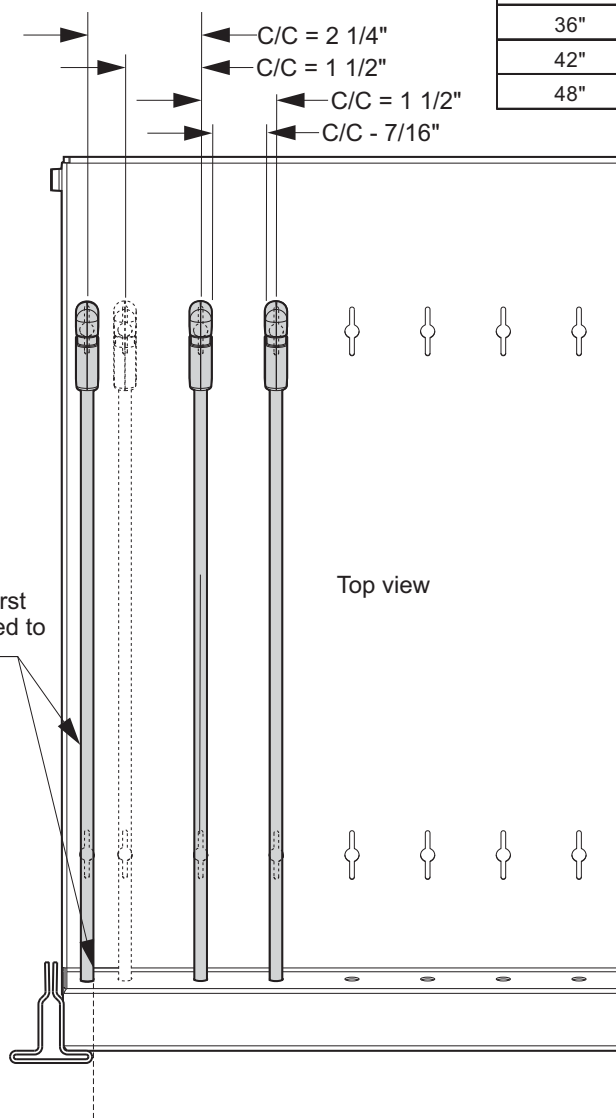
Sloped shelf guides (optional)

Preinstall all guides before installing shelves into the shelving.

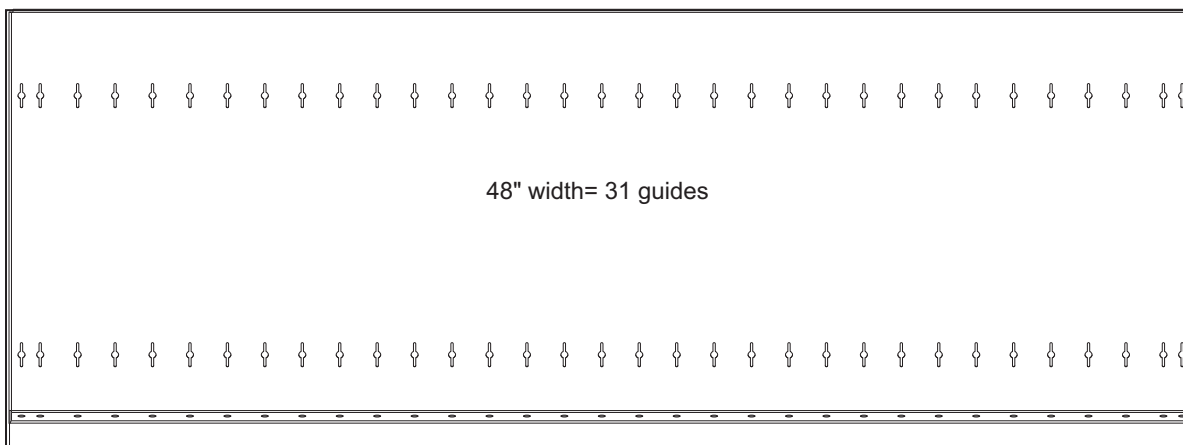
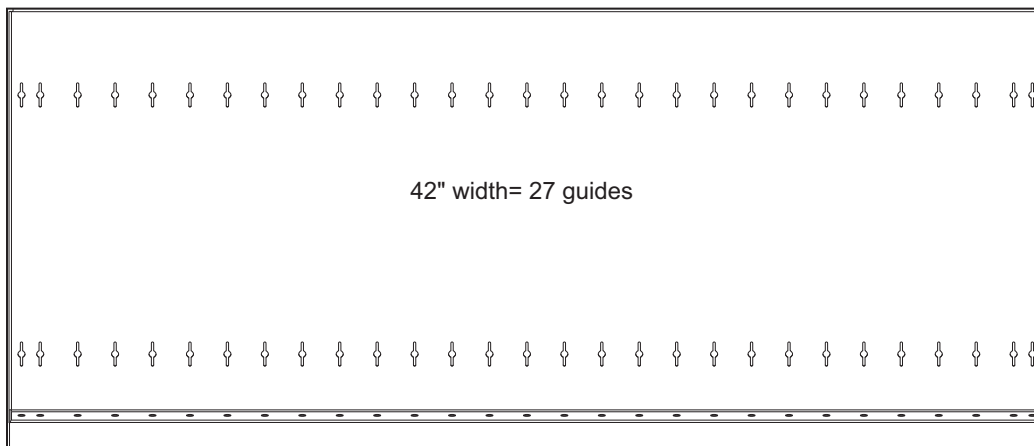
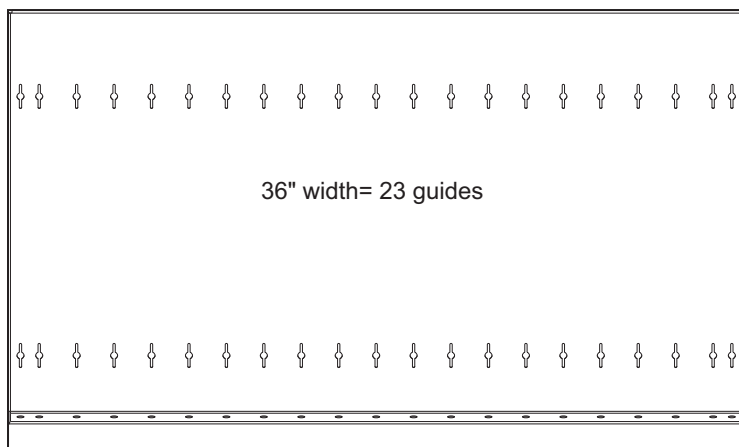
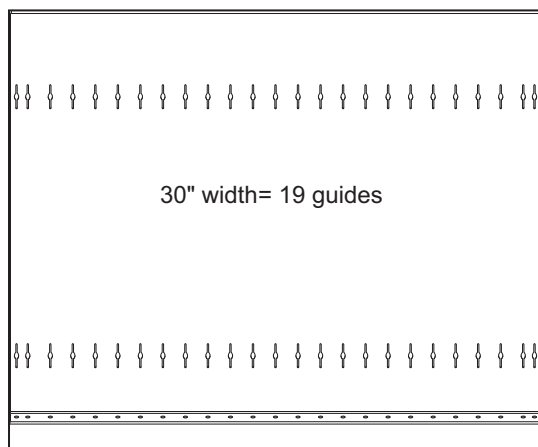
2 positions are possible for the first guide. The first position is designed to clear the post of the shelf.

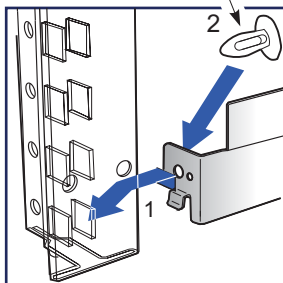


Anchoring, base and shelves

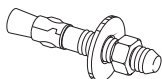
1 Base

If required, the front base must be installed **before** the lower shelf is put in place.

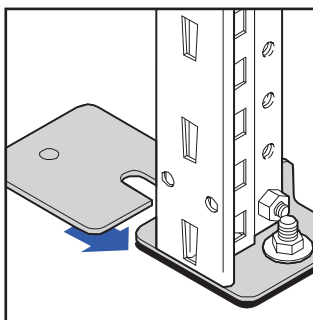
Clip non-mandatory



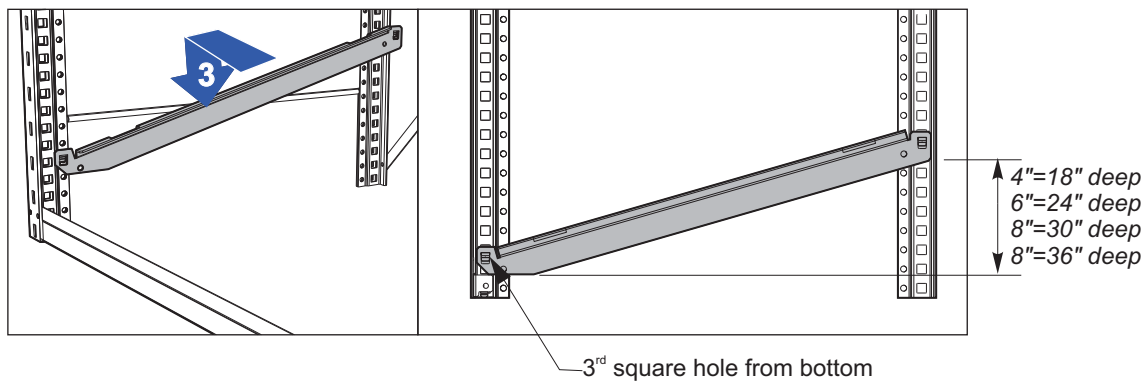
2 Anchoring and Leveling



Always start to install the shelves from the bottom to the top of the shelving

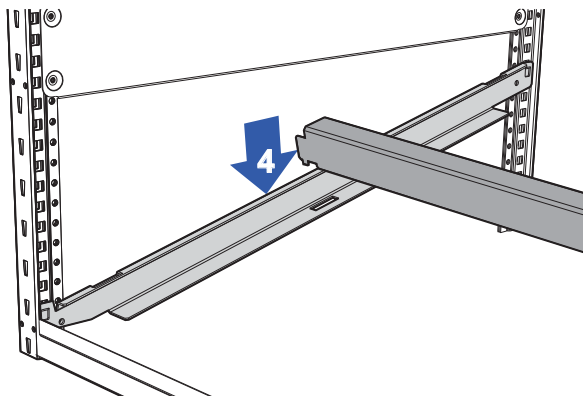


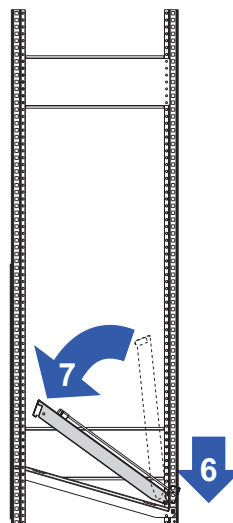
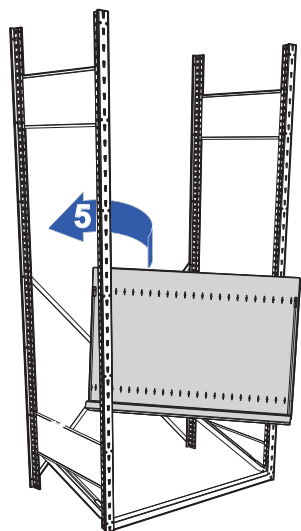
3 Place left and right bracket for the bottom shelf.



4 Reinforcement

30 and 36" deep shelf reinforcement. (optional)





Lower the front at first.

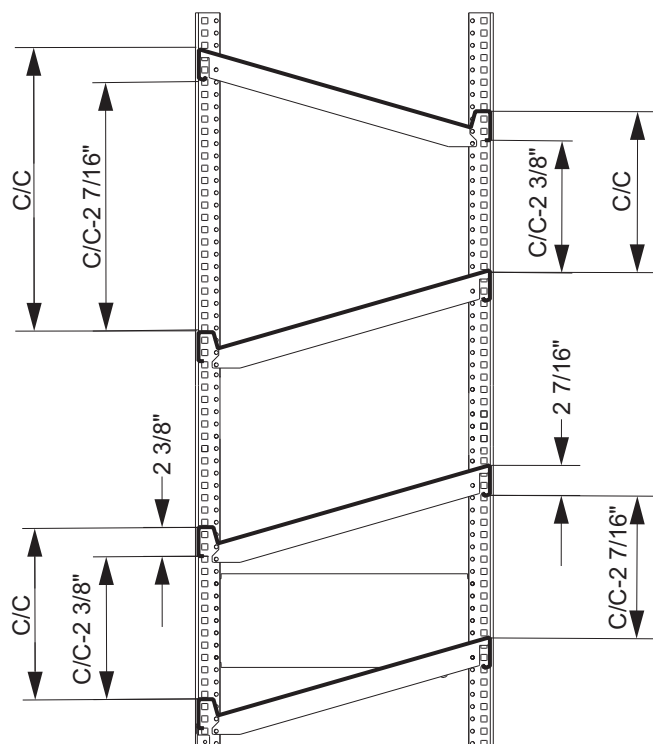
Distance between shelves

8 Second shelf

Repeat step 3 to 7 for second shelf from the bottom of the shelving.



Possible shelf adjustment of 2" in height if use with corner gussets.

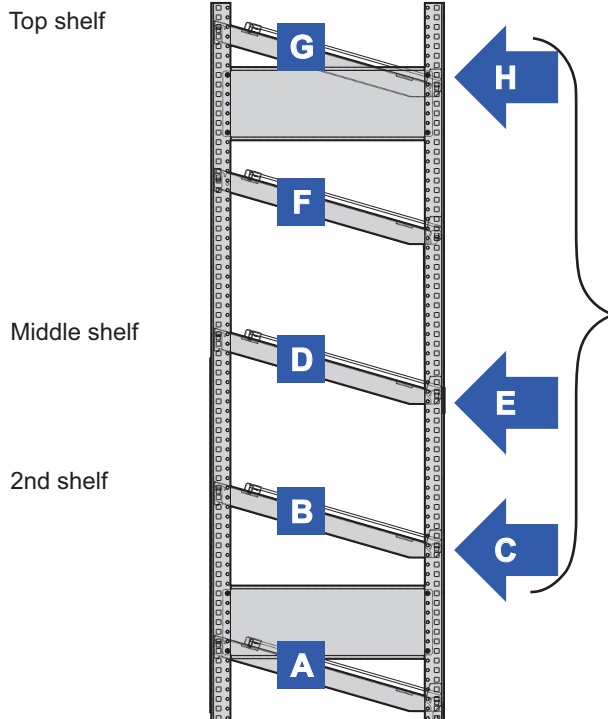
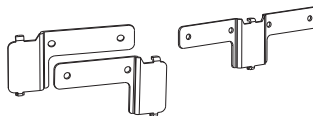


Corner gussets



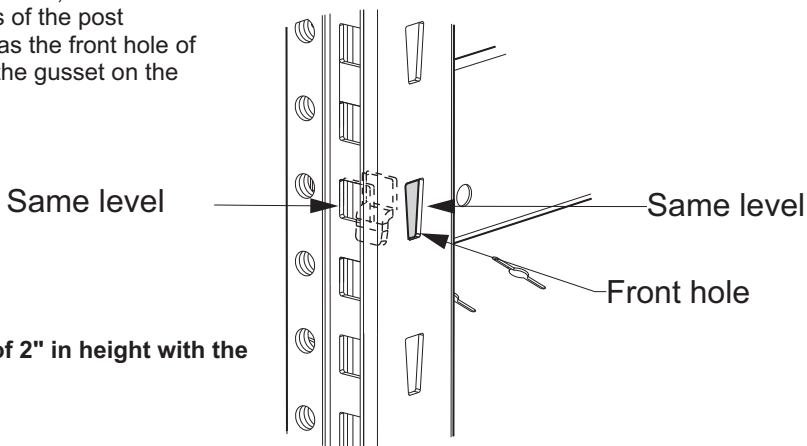
Corner gussets:

For shelving without back sway brace or back panels, 3 kits of corner gussets must be installed. On the second, the middle, and the top shelf.

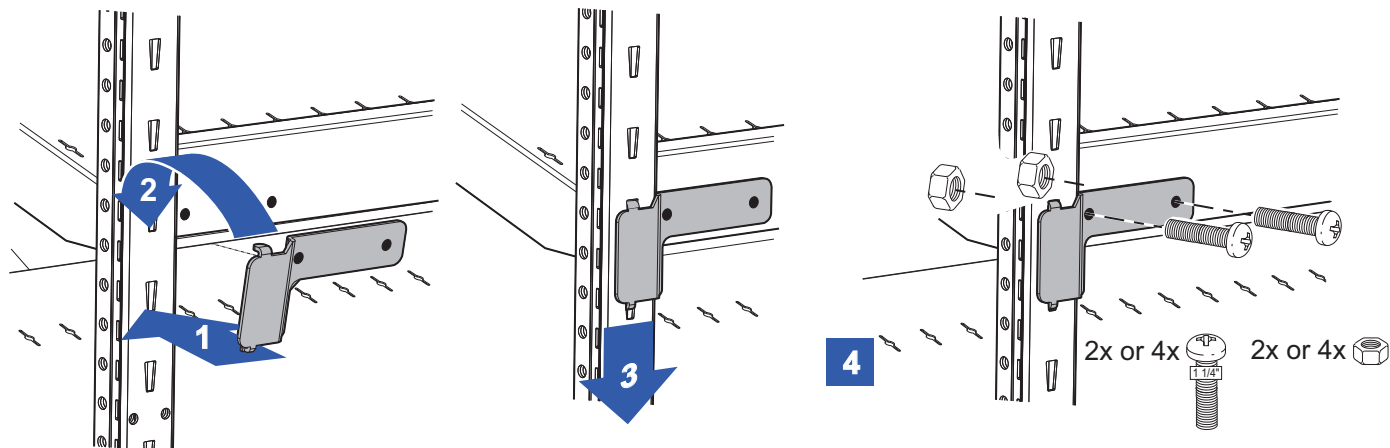


Positioning the shelf with corner gussets:

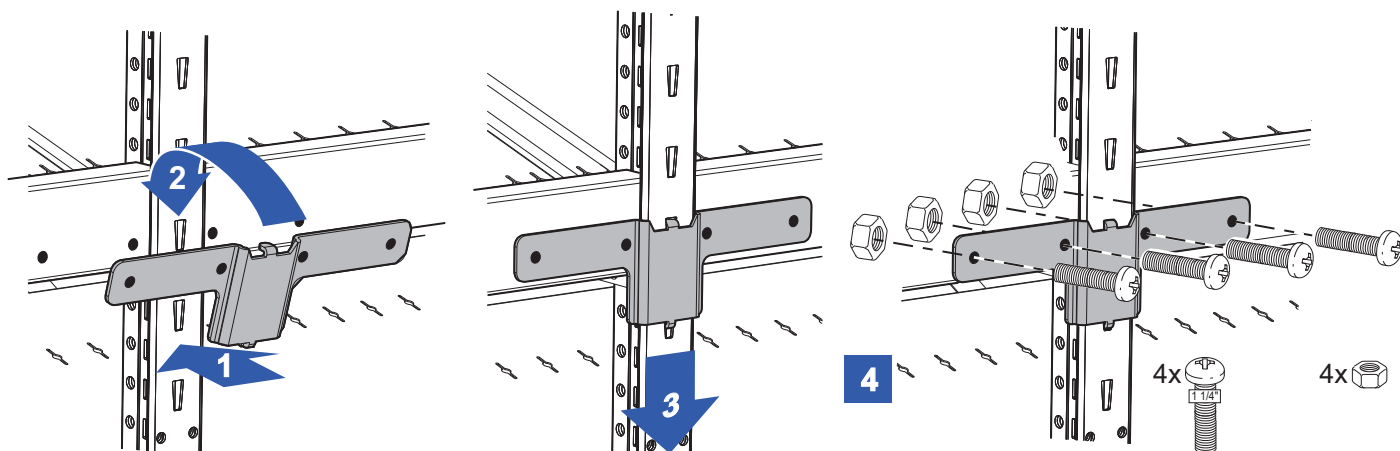
If the shelving uses corner gussets, the shelves must be installed on the holes of the post positioning at the same level as the front hole of the post, to be able to screw the gusset on the shelf.



Possible shelf adjustment of 2" in height with the gussets



Use this gusset when the shelving are assembly in continuously



The corner gusset are not compatible with the back-to-back shelving installations.
